NAR bets on Upstream with additional \$9M in funding

WASHINGTON – On May 20, the board of directors of the National Association of Realtors® (NAR) approved an additional \$9 million in funding for broker data management platform Upstream. The company behind the platform, UpstreamRE, is expected to repay the funds when it achieves profitability. The funds -- \$500,000 this year and \$1 million in 2018 for administrative costs -- will be in the form of loans and taken out of NAR's operating reserves, which currently stand at about \$75 million, John Pierpoint, NAR's chief financial officer, said at the Realtors® Legislative Meetings and Trade Expo this week. The increased funding signals NAR leaders' willingness hedge its bets on a venture that promises to put real estate data in the control of the trade group's 1.2 million members, rather than companies the association views as well-funded outsiders, particularly Zillow Group.
