

ADVISORY TO BUYER REGARDING RECORDING DEVICES

- 1 Recording devices are common, including inside and outside peoples' homes. When buyers view a property for sale, the seller may be monitoring
- 2 what they say and do. Most sellers use recording devices for security purposes, but the devices can also gather information about a buyer. If buyers
- 3 are not careful, they can disclose all kinds of confidential information, from how much they might be willing to pay to how important it is to purchase
- 4 the property.
- 5 Buyers should be careful about what they say while touring a property. Because devices can be hidden, it is best to assume they are present and not 6 say anything that might weaken the buyer's bargaining position. If possible, buyers should wait until they are outside the property and outside the 7 range of monitoring devices before saying anything about the price, bidding strategy, or other important information.
- 8 Real estate agents are able to talk with buyers about how to talk securely about their experience during a property tour.
