



What is a Business Day?

OREF Sale Agreements and ORS 696 define business days as days other than Saturday, Sunday, Federal legal holidays, and Oregon legal holidays. If a holiday falls on a Sunday, the following Monday is observed as the legal holiday. If it falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday is the observed legal holiday.

Please note, this list can change at any moment due to ORS 187.020, Additional legal holidays, which states that in addition to those specified in ORS 187.010, the following days are legal holidays in this state:

(1) Every day appointed by the Governor as a holiday.

(2) Every day appointed by the President of the United States as a day of mourning, rejoicing or other special observance only when the Governor also appoints that day as a holiday.
